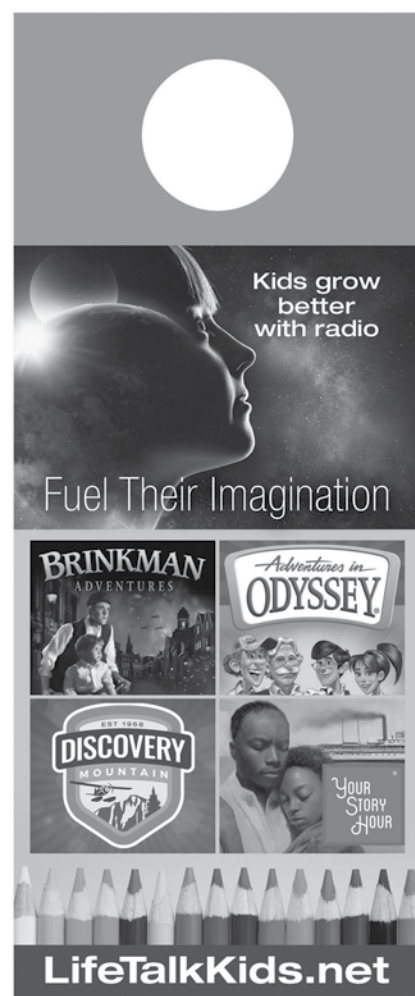

According to a survey done by Civic Science, nearly 60% of our population supports putting a warning label on social media platforms to alert users to the potential dangers of mental health.

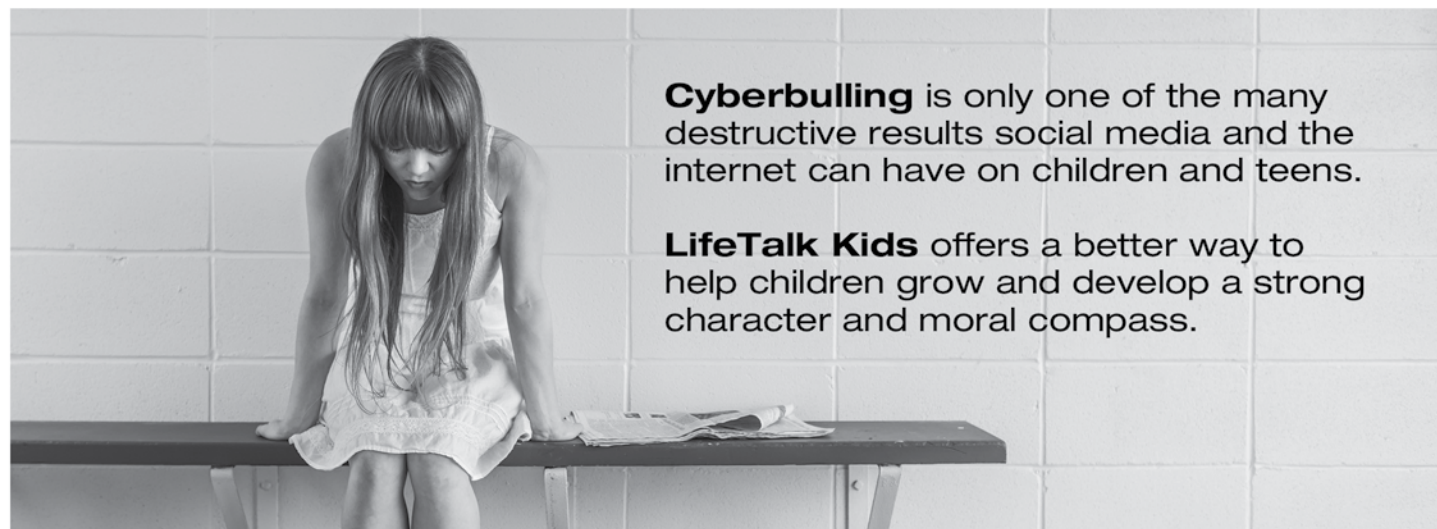

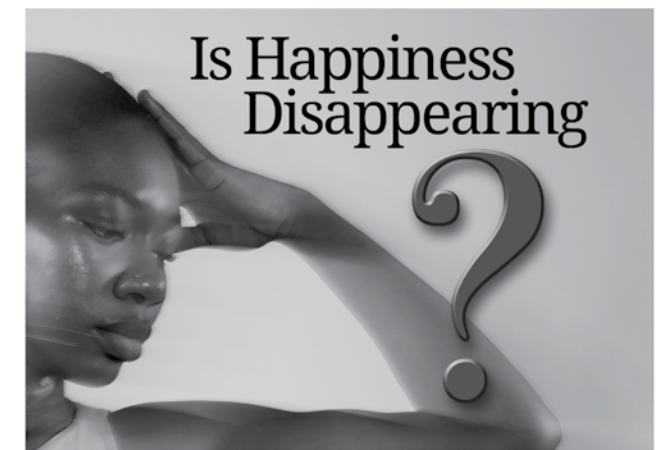
4. Pray! Prayer can make a difference.
