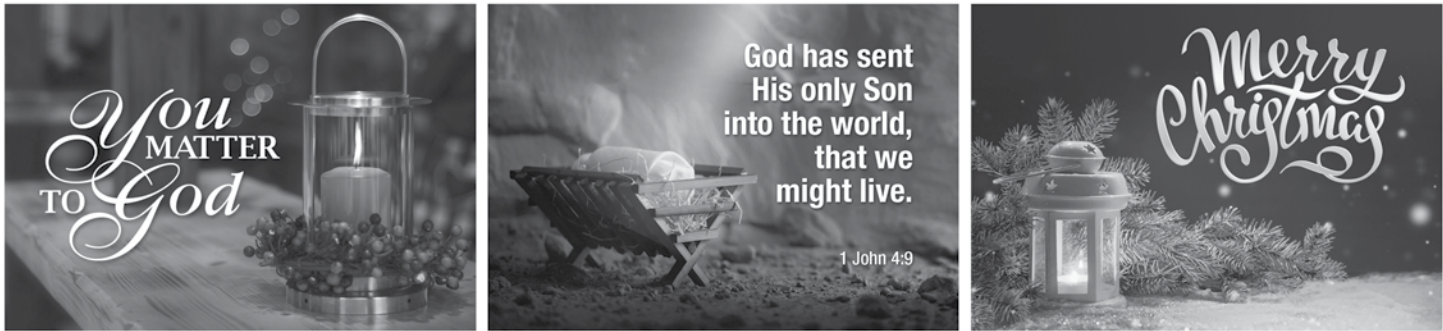


Use Sharing Cards for Thanksgiving and Christmas
