Dear Partner,

A hundred years ago, before homes in America had television or the internet, families would huddle around the radio for news and entertainment. Radio broadcasting began to appear in the 1920s when the first commercial stations were launched. A wooden box containing a radio brought instant information into homes during the Great Depression. Of special interest were the popular Fireside Chats presented by Franklin Roosevelt between 1933 and 1944. This gave the president direct access to the lives of individual Americans and families. He explained policies and communicated hope in times of uncertainty.

Radio ownership grew rapidly and by 1940 most American homes had a radio. During World War II movie theaters would show newsreels ahead of the feature, but most families depended daily on their radio for general communication. Radio provided the fastest way to receive information.



Although TV, mobile devices and the internet influences much of our communication today, radio still dominates today's media. Radio continues to have the highest reach across all age groups. It reaches more people than any other traditional or digital media—more than social media, online video or television.


